Eight children by this marriage; William S. "Redney", Daniel, James H., Damon Edward, Gregg, Matthew, John and a dau. Laura Ann who married Hiram Snyder. His son, Daniel Flatt, names these children in the 1905 history of Greene County, Illinos.
