Flatt, Martha Serilda 1844 Jun 12 1942

Birth date of 1844 taken fromn tombstone. Daughter of Andrew Grissam of West Virginia. Census records show that she was born in Tennessee. Married William S. "Redney" Flatt, Dec. 1, 1869, in Greene County, Illinois. Died in Bluffdale twsp., Greene County, Ill. Obituary in the Carrollton Patriot, June 19, 1942, states that she was born March 25, 1845. Mother of 7 children; Five sons; John Thomas Flatt, James Daniel Flatt, Damon Edward Flatt, Earid Flatt, & Milton "Scotty" Flatt, and Two daughters; Mary E. Flatt married 1st to Walter Winchell, & 2nd to Allen T. Miller, and Elvira Flatt who married Clarence R. Chism.

Flatt, Martha (Chapman) see, ADAMS, Martha Flatt

Flatt, Mary E. Jul 4 1847 Dec 16 1866

Aged 19 years, 5 months, & 12 days. This would have made birth, July 4, 1847. Married William S. "Redney" Flatt, April 19, 1866. In the 1860 census of Scott County, Illinois - T14N, R13W - P. O. Naples, Illinois - Family 1077 we find MARY E. MOORE, age 15 years, living in the home of S. H. Clemens & his wife Elizabeth. The Elizabeth is probably a sister to Mary. Marriage records show Samuel H. Clement and Elizabeth Moore were married June 28, 1857 in Scott County.

Flatt, Milton "Scotty" Sep 27 1885 Mar 28 1967

Born in Bluffdale twsp., Greene County, Ill. a son of William S. "Redney" and Martha Serilda (Grissam) Flatt. Married Mabel Shaw, the daughter of Robert Kay & Lillie Belle (Smith) Shaw. He was buried in Richwoods cemetery, but later moved to Memorial Gardens, Eldred, Ill. He was survived by his wife; Five daughters; Mrs. Frances Hedrick, Kirkwood, Mo., Mrs. Arvella Plato of Jerseyville, Mrs. Doris Devine, & Mrs. Lois Griffin of Eldred, & Mrs. Shirley Lasley of Jacksonville, and two sons, William and Harold of Eldred.

Flatt, Minnie M. 1878 Aug 13 1944

The 3rd wife of James Daniel Flatt. A daughter of John & Margaret (Allred) Burnett. This was also her 3rd marriage. Died in Greeme Co.

Flatt, Nancy Aug 31 1832 Feb 18 1868

Age 30 years, 8 months, & 18 days. Born in Hamilton County, Illinois, a daughter of Joseph & Nancy (Chaffur) Shelton. Married Aaron Flatt, Jan. 2, 1849, in Hamilton Co., Ill. Mother of 8 children. see, FLATT, Aaron

Flatt, Nellie Feb 20 1872 Jul 14 1939

Born in Edinburg, Illinois, a daughter of Thomas & Eliza (Parrish) Reece. Married John T. Flatt, Sept. 27, 1911, in Greene County, Ill. His 2nd and her 3rd marriage. The Carrollton Gazette, July 21, 1939 reports the death of Mrs. John Flatt, 67, died July 13 at her home in Wrights. Born Ellen Louise Reece, Feb. 20, 1872, at Edinburg, she was the daughter of Thomas and Eliza Reece. Husband & 6 children survive. When she married John T. Flatt she used the name Nellie. Death certificate state death July 14, 1939. Tombstone reads _NELLIE._

Flatt, Ransom 1816 1872

Born in Barren County, Kentucky, a son of Edward & Rosannah (Garrison) Flatt. Married Sarah Ann Reed, July 11, 1844, in Greene County. Died in Bluffdale twsp. at the age of 56 years. Children; Rhoda married James I. Crane, Louisa married Silas Stone, William M. married Eugenia/Lougenia Bradford and Dennis was born June 2, 1847 and died July 22, 1867.

Flatt, Raymond Jennings Sep 6 1899 Jul 12 1981

Son of Ernest & Bessie Gertrue (Hermans) Flatt. Born in Bluffdale twsp., Greene County, Ill. Married Eva Irene Reynolds, Feb. 28, 1923, in Greene County, Illinois. Died in Calhoun County, Ill. Children; Alma Flatt married Bert Schaaf, Mildred Flatt married James Galore, Florence Flatt married Leonard Halemeyer, Lilly Flatt married James Honey and James Flatt married Evelyn I. Riley.

Flatt, Rhoda Apr 25 1865

Aged 55 years, 3 months, and 24 days. Born in Kentucky a daughter of Dennis & Nelly (Laird/Lard) Kelly. Married 1st to Asa Ray, May 1, 1831, in Wayne County, Illinois. License issued 30 April 1831. Proved by affidavit from County Clerk of Wayne County, Ill., dated 2 May 1883, to help prove service in the Black Hawk War. Needed for bounty land claim. 3 children by her marriage to Asa Ray; Nancy Ray 1832-1834, David Ray 1834-1842, and Rhoda Malinda Ray who married Horatio Bandy, 1836-1911. The 2nd marriage of Rhoda was to Jesse Flatt, Dec. 5, 1839, in Greene County. For their children, see, FLATT, Jesse.

__NOTE__ - Rhoda was a sister of Unis/Eunice Kelly the wife of Aaron Flatt- Rachel Kelly who married Jesse McCracken & Russell Curry - Eleanor/Ellen Kelly who married David Reese - and Martha Kelly who married Hezekiah Patterson. Euncie & Rachel are buried in this cemetery. Martha Patterson is buried in Eldred cemetery. I do not know where Ellen Reece is buried. She also had sisters; Mary who married James Taylor and Elizabeth who married John Lard/Laird, both buried in Sangamon County, Ill. and a sister, Millie who married Jonas Todd in St. Louis 13, Jan. 1831. There appears to have been 5 brothers, however I have found no trace of them.

Flatt, Robert Ransom May 5 1878 Apr 1 1970

Probably born in Bluffdale twsp. a son of William & Eugenia/Lugenia (Bradford) Flatt. Married Estella Flatt, April 7, 1901, in Greene County, Ill. Died in Jacksonville, Morgan Co., Ill. Survived by a stepdaughter, Mrs. Charles Carver, of Joplin, Missouri., and a brother, Dennis Flatt, of Kelso, Washington. see. FLATT, Estella. -- _NOTE_ Eugenia/Lugenia Bradford Flatt, the mother of Robert Ransom Flatt, was a daughter of Robert Bradford and Rosa Looper

Born in Walkerville twsp. a daughter of Willis E. & Addie May (McClennen) Chapman. Survived by husband, her parents and 4 children; Frank Jr. and Donald both in the service; and Larry, and Audry; and nine brothers and sisters; John of Glasgow, William & Mrs. Bulford Shaw of Eldred, Russell of White Hall, Glendon, Harry and Vernon of Hillview, Virgil of Rockbridge and Ethel of Kentucky.

Flatt, Rosannah "Rosie" Aug 5 1973

Age 99 years. Born in Surry County, North Carolina, a daughter of James & Hester/Esther Ann Roberts. She was married to Edward Flatt, June 19, 1810, in Barren County, Kentucky. Died in Bluffdale twsp., Greene County, Ill. The reading on her tombstone says "Rosie". The census records show many different ages, however the age on the tombstone is probably very near correct. She and Edward Flatt had 8 children; James Flatt who married 1st to Mary Garrison and 2nd to Mrs. Elizabeth Boswell, probably in Wayne of Hamilton County, Ill., Patience Flatt who married 1st to ______ Bradford and 2nd to Calton Harper, Jesse Flatt who married 1st to Rhoda Kelly and 2nd to Jeanette Taylor, John Flatt who married 1st to Elizabeth Garrison and 2nd to Martha Chapman, Ransom Flatt who married Sarah "Sally" Ann Reid, Mary Ann Flatt who married Alexander Logan, Aaron Flatt who married 1st to Nancy Shelton and 2nd to Clarissa Williams Clark, and David Flatt who married Mahulda Jane McCracken. Rosannah had a son Daniel Looper. I have not been able to find a marriage of Rosannah and a Looper.

Flatt, Roswell Dec 19 1869 Mar 26 1930

No tombstone found. Married Anna N. Camerer, July 3, 1926, in Greene County, Illinois. Born in Bluffdale twsp. and died in Greene County. The Carrollton Patriot, April 3, 1930.

Aged 56 yrs. 8 months & 13 days. Maiden name Reid. Married Ranson Flatt, July 11, 1844, in Greene county, III.

Flatt, Sarah Susan Apr 8 1857 Jan 10 1942

Born in Greene County a daughter of Walter & Mary Ann (Silkwood) McAdams. Married Damon Flatt, Oct. 8, 1879, in Greene County, Ill. Died in Bluffdale twsp. Two children; Nona Flatt who married Harold Wayham, and Harrison Obiadah Flatt.

Flatt, William Mar 15 1854 Aug 31 1903

Son of Ransom & Sarah Ann (Reid) Flatt. Married Lugenia Bradford, Aug. 20,. 1877, in Greene Cunty, Illinois. Two children; Robert Ranson Flatt married Estella Flatt, Dennis Silas Flatt who maried Stella Shanklin. & William Edward who died in 1887.

Flatt, William Edward Sep 27 1883 Feb 5 1887

Son of William & Lugenia (Bradford) Flatt. Born and died in Greene Co.

Flatt, William S. "Redney" Oct 11 1842 Mar 2 1921

Son of John & Elizabeth (Garrison) Flatt. Married 1st to Mary E.Moore, April 19, 1866, in Winchester, Scott County, Ill. Married 2nd, Dec 1, 1869 to Martha Serilda Grissam, Dec. 1, 1869, in Greene County. Ill. Born and died in Bluffdale twsp. 7 children; John, James Daniel, Damon, Earid, Mary, Milton "Scotty", Alvira & Mary.

Fleener, Robert A. May 12 1919 Jun 26 1919

Foreman, Samuel G. Feb 24 1872

Aged 74 years, 4 months, 24 days

Fox, Mary C. 1883 1951

Maiden name Mary C. Shackleford. Married 1st to J. Lee Chapman and married 2nd to Grover Fox. SEE, Chapman, Mary C.

Gamble, Ann Eliza Apr 18 1860

Aged 20 years, 13 days. Daughter of Aaron & Malinda Gamble. In the 1850 census of Greene County this family was living in the vicinity of this cemetery. family 909, Gamble, Aaron 49 Pa. Cooper Malinda 46 Va.

John C. 20 III. Farmer

Aaron C. 18 III. Farmer Catharine C. 16 III Martom V. 13 III. ANN E. 10 III.

The families of John Gamble and William Gamble also lived in this vicinity. The Gambles' came from Pa. & were probably brothers.

Garrison, Elizabeth see, FLATT, Elizabeth

Garrison, G. W.

There is some question about his being buried here. There is a marker that reads Sergt. Co. H. 91 III. Inf. This George W. Garrison was a son of George W. & Anna (Lard/Lord/Laird) Garrison. His sister Mary married James Flatt. The military marker on this grave is in the same plot with John H. Flatt who was a son of James and Mary (Garrison) Flatt. He was the father of Georgianna Garrison who married Orson Logan. I HAVE NOT BEEN ABLE TO FIND A DEATH DATE FOR THIS GEORGE W. GARRISON. There were two GEORGE W. GARRISONS who served in the Civil War. They enlisted the same day in the same company, under the same officers. They both became sergeants and were mustered out the same day. The other George W. Garrison is buried in the Likely cemetery in Walkerville twsp., Greene County, III.

For names of brothers & sisters, see, Camerer, William T. -- The Carrollton Patriot, Dec. 5, 1907 (20 years ago column - 1887) - Travis Ray and Lillie Camerer were married at Bluffdale. In the obituary of Travis Ray it names Lillie Camerer as his 1st wife and three children born to them; Mrs. Clinton Short of Rockbridge, Irvin of Jerseyville and Llynn. see, RAY, Lindsey. - The Carrollton Patriot, Aug. 11, 1899 - John Q. Gill and Mrs. Lillian Ray married in Jerseyville, Thursday.

Gillingham, Lueza/Louisa May 1 1849 May 19 1871

Daughter of Joseph Walter and Mary Ann (Silkwood) McAdams. Her parents are buried in Belltown cemetery. Samuel Gillingham and Louisa McAdams married 24 June 1867, in Greene County, Illinois.

Gillingham, May A. Sep 16 1870 Aug 16 1872 Daughter of Samuel & Louisa (McAdams) Gillingham.

Gillingham, Vaneatton Jul 1 1868 Jul 4 1869 infant son of Samuel & Louisa (McAdams) Gillingham.

Goans, Caroline M. 1857 1933

Wife of William Leonard Goans. Maiden name Caroline M. Brosi. There is a Jacob & Frances Brosi buried in Dayton cemetery, Woodville twsp. They may be the parents of Caroline M. Goans.

Goans, Ethel M. Aug 18 1987

Alton Telegraph - Ethel M. Goans, 76, died at 5:50 A. M. Tuesday, Aug. 18, 1987, at Boyd Memorial Hospital in Carrollton. She was born in Greene County, a daughter of the late Lynus & Addie B. (Regelien) Benner. She married Roy Goans Sr., Nov. 15, 1929, in Carrollton and he died June 7, 1969. Surviving are two daughters, Virginia Goans of White Hall and Charlotte White of Carrollton; one son, Roy Goans Jr. of Carrollton; four grandchildren; two great grandchildren; one step great grandchild; and one brother Gene Benner of Ohio.

Survived by his wife and two daughters, Miss Virginia Goans and Mrs. William (Charlotte) White of Carrollton, and one son, Roy Goans Jr. of Carrollton; and four grandchildren. Also surviving are two brothers, Jake Goans of Carrollton and William Goans of Wood River. Four sister and a brother preceded him in death.

The Carrollton Patriot, Aug. 8, 1912 - Mrs. Sarah Caroline Reece died at her home in Eldred, Sat. at age of 68 years, 7 months, & 3 days. Services were at Eldred and burial in Richwoods cemetery. Mrs. Reece was the eldest daughter of Charles and Cordelia Shipman and was born Jan. 1, 1844. She was the mother of 8 children, 6 surviving; Fannie, wife of George Browning of Pearl; Jesse Halbert of Walla Walla, Wash.; George Halbert and Edgar Brown of White Hall; Robert Halbert of Eldred; Josephine, wife of Hinton Schafer of Chicago. There are also 2 sisters, 2 brothers, 11 grandchildren and 3 great grandchildren. - She married 1st to Hiram Halbert, March 27, 1862. Married 2nd to Nathaniel Brown, July 29, 1880. She married 3rd to Thomas Benton Reese.

Aged 10 months & 28 days. Daughter of A. F. & M. J. Halbert.

Halbert, Leslie Jul 7 1871

Aged 13 months & 9 days. Son of Harrison C. & Mary (Jennings) Halbert.

Harrison C. & Mary E. Jennings were married, Nov. 5, 1857, in Greene County, Ill.

Halbert, Lewis L. Mar 6 1879 May 20 1910

The Carrollton Patriot, May 26, 1910 - Lewis Halbert, of St. Louis, died last Friday, May 20, 1910, at the home of his father Edward Halbert. Age 31 years. Born March 6, 1879 in Bluffdale twsp. Married Nellie Hahn of St. Louis. Widow and 3 children survive.

Halbert Lucy

The Carrollton Patriot, Nov. 20, 1913 - (20 years ago column) Miss Lucy Halbert died, age 25 years. -- She was a daughter of Hiram Halbert and was probably buried in Richwoods.

Halbert, Margaret Dec 22 1856 Mar 18 1879

Wife of Albert Edward Halbert. Maiden name Margaret E. Stone.

Halbert, Mary E. Feb 8 1861

Aged 4 years, 8 months & 8 days. Daughter of J. W. & Sarah (Lakin) Halbert.

Halbert, Nellie Oct 30 1911

The Carrollton Patriot, Nov. 9, 1911 - Nellie Hahn widow of the late Louis Halbert died, Oct. 30, in St. Louis, age 29 years. Burial in Richwoods cemetery. White Hall Register - Mrs. Louis Halbert died in St. Louis, age 29 years. Funeral Nov. 2, 1911. 3 children; Albert & Harry, twins age 8 years, and Goldie age 5 years. Died Oct. 30, 1911. Carrollton Patriot, June 6, 1912 - Mrs. Nellie Halbert who died last Oct. was disinterred and taken to Farmington, Missouri for final interment.
