R. B. Huitt, C. J. Gardner and John King settled in this Township in 1821. In 1827, came Gen. J. B. Fry, now of the United States Army, and James Stone. In 1821, C. J. Scoggins and James Martin. The Southeastern and Northwestern portions of this Township is excellent lands and well

improved. From the Northeast to the Southwest runs Macoupin Creek. The Chicago, Alton & St. Louis R. R. runs across the Northeast corner. For stock and grain raising this Township has few superiors
